Requirements:

Details:

- Cost of course is \$1,500 USD. Cost includes: Registration fee, all course materials, system access and one exam. Fee is due at the time of application.
- The student academy course content is the same SAP Solution Academy course offering TERP10: mySAP ERP Integrated Business Processes.
- Course will be offered at Drexel University, Korman Computing Center (located at 33rd Street between Market and Chestnut), in Philadelphia.
- 10 day intensive course, classroom lectures 9am - 5pm Monday to Friday (weekend off). Plan to study / review each evening.
- Certification exam is taken on the last day. The 3 hour exam is taken online and consists of 80 questions. Test is pass/fail. Students are typically notified of the results within one month of exam.
- Typical exam pass rate is 75%.
